

Regulations

Gymkhana

Popular individual mountain bike race for children, in the form of an obstacle course.

The race takes place in Château-d'Oex, on September 21, 2019. Departure in the order of categories according to the official program.

- Elimination race for children from 3 to 5 on a simplified asphalt course.
- Mountain bike Gymkhana for children from 6 to 15 on a modified course with different challenges.

Conditions of participation: Anyone born between 2004 and 2016. Young people born in 2004 and 2005 can only take part in one of the two events (Gymkhana or VTT-24).

- Mini girls (years 2014-2015-2016)
- Mini boys (years 2014-2015-2016)
- Kids 1 girls (years 2012-2013)
- Kids 1 boys (years 2012-2013)
- Kids 2 girls (years 2010-2011)
- Kids 2 boys (years 2010-2011)
- Juniors girls (years 2008-2009)
- Juniors boys (years 2008-2009)
- Cracks girls (years 2006-2007)
- Cracks boys (years 2006-2007)
- Stars girls (years 2004-2005)
- Stars boys (years 2004-2005)

Registration Fee:

CHF 15 for all categories

Registration:

On-site or via the www.vtt-24.ch site.

Insurance:

Every participant must have valid accident insurance and civil liability insurance coverage. The organization does not accept any liability:

- in cases of accidents or defects due to the competitor's poor health;
- in cases of accidents or defects due to the competitor's poor judgment (not adjusting one's riding style to the terrain or overestimating one's physical capacities);
- in cases of accidents or defects due to the poor condition of personal equipment;
- in cases of accidents caused by non-compliance with traffic regulations and/or specific safety instructions;
- in cases of theft, damage, or loss of objects or equipment before, during and after the event. Each racer is fully responsible for all the equipment he or she may need for the event.

First Aid:

A first aid station will be set up in the reception hall infirmary. This station will be manned by a certified first aid team.

Complaints:

Complaints are admissible, in writing, within 15 minutes after the display of provisional results. The team leader will be the sole contact for the race jury.

Only the organization is qualified to settle any disputes and its decisions are final. The race marshals are authorized to penalize cheating and, therefore, to make changes to the ranking based on the penalties given.

Image Rights:

Photos and videos will be shot during the event. By participating, every competitor authorizes the dissemination of these pictures and thereby waives any right thereto.

Modification of Regulations:

The organizer reserves the right to modify these regulations. The leader of each team is responsible for staying up-to-date by consulting the www.vtt-24.ch site.

General:

In the event of a dispute, the French version of these regulations prevails.
